

100 Trees for 100 Years

WHAT: To celebrate the 100th Anniversaries of our camps, the NEPA chapter of the National Eagle Scout Association (NESA) is conducting a program to plant 100 oak trees in our Council area.

HOW: Trees will be planted at the Council camps and in public parks. The trees will have a marker to tell passersby about the camps' centennial, and who planted and who sponsored the trees. The saplings will be about 3-5 feet in height. Approximately 30-40% of the trees will be planted at the camps, with the rest planted at public venues to remind the general public of our scout camps' value.

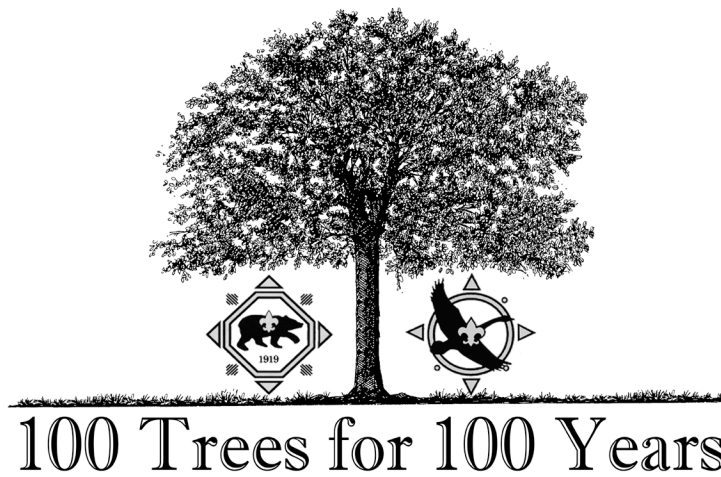
WHO: Any scouting unit or scouting alumni can register to plant one or more trees. NEPA-NESA is coordinating the acquisition of the trees and markers. It is the responsibility of the unit/group to secure prior permission from town parks to plant the tree(s). Groups registered to plant trees at the council camps will plant at locations designated by the camp directors.

WHEN: The team makes the arrangement for the planting date. The months of May and June, as well as September are suited for helping a tree become established. Tree-planting teams must coordinate with the council office for the dates they'd like to plant their trees. CAMP CENTENNIAL SERVICE MEDAL: Plantings for this program meet the camp service project requirement for either the Acahela Centennial Service Medal or the GPSR Centennial Service Medal, but not both.
